Scope of Responsibilities

Background:

The Tata Cancer Care Foundation (formerly known as Alamelu Charitable Foundation) has been set-up by Tata Trusts to implement the cancer care programme, based on the four pillars of access, affordability, quality and awareness. Since 2017, more than 20 facilities in six states- Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Jharkhand, Maharashtra, Uttar Pradesh and Karnataka — have been developed and augmented through collaborations with state governments and like-minded organisations. TCCF runs a state-of-the-art Oncopathology Lab in Mumbai, which focuses on cancer diagnosis and upskilling pathologists. TCCF is committed to down-staging the impact of the disease by facilitating early detection by building awareness, screening and improving the quality of life of cancer patients and their families.

Key Accountability:

- Complete frequent daily Patient visits .
- Supervise Nursing Staff .
- Diagnose patients and develop treatment plans .
- Order referrals for diagnostic testing with other medical providers .
- Accurately Chart patient treatment plan .
- Prescribe appropriate drugs to patients, as treatment plans dictate .
- Explain procedures in simple terms to patients and family members before and after procedures.
- Advise patients and community members concerning diet, activity, hygiene, & prevention .
- Provide health and wellness advice to patients.
- Monitor patients' conditions and progress and reevaluate treatments as necessary.
- Advise surgeon of a patient's risk status and recommend appropriate intervention to minimize risk.
- To help formulate Infection control policy of the hospital. Help in ICU as needed.
- Preparation of Drug Formulary for the hospital .
